**STIPULATION AND ORDER  
REGARDING SPOUSAL  
SUPPORT**

**WHEREAS**, the parties were divorced on August 1, 2019 via Combined Marital Termination Agreement and Stipulated Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, Order for Judgment and Judgment and Decree for Dissolution of Marriage (herein after “Order”);

**WHEREAS**, as part of the mutually agreed upon Order, Respondent was ordered to pay Petitioner \$2,000 per month in permanent spousal maintenance;

**WHEREAS**, the parties have agreed to modify the monthly spousal maintenance amount and duration and wish to memorialize said agreement;

**WHEREAS**, the parties mutually request the Court enter an Order on this matter as described herein without further notice or appearance to any party;

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. **Petitioner:** Nancy Roessler (hereinafter may be referred to as “Wife” or “Petitioner”) and is represented in these proceedings by Roger H. Hippert, Blethen Berens, 219 North Broadway, Suite C, New Ulm, MN 56073.

2. **Respondent:** Richard Beran (hereinafter may be referred to as “Husband” or “Respondent”) 55024 and is represented in these proceedings by Jason C. Kohlmeyer, Kohlmeyer Hagen Law Office, 150 St. Andrews Court, Suite 110, Mankato, MN 56001.
3. **Respondent’s Retirement:** Respondent recently sold his shares in Kind Vet Clinic and is officially retired. As such, his monthly income is significantly reduced from what it was at the time of the party’s divorce.
4. **Spousal Support – Amount:** Due to these changes the parties agree a reduction in the amount of spousal support he pays is necessary. The parties agree that Respondent will pay to Petitioner \$1350 per month beginning on March 1, 2024.
5. **Spousal Support – Duration:** The parties further agree that, based on Respondent’s reduction in income, a termination date for the spousal support should be established. The parties agree that Respondent’s last month of paying spousal support will be December 2027.
6. **Future Modification of Spousal Support:** The parties agree that the new agreement is fair and equitable. They have both received consideration, specifically that Respondent will not attempt to eliminate his spousal support obligation, and the parties have had full disclosure of their respective financial circumstances. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. §518.552, subd. 5, and Karon v Karon, the parties have agreed that neither of them may return to the Court in the future to have the Court modify the issue of spousal maintenance award and the Court shall permanently be divested of jurisdiction in regard to the issue of spousal maintenance from here after the signing of this Agreement by the Court


**NOW, THEREFORE,** based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, the following is adopted as the Order of this Court and the parties agree that the Court shall issue the following as its permanent order:

**ORDER**

1. Beginning March 1, 2024, Respondent’s monthly spousal support payment to Petitioner shall be reduced to \$1350.
2. Respondent shall continue to make monthly spousal support payments of \$1350 until and through December 2027, at which point his spousal support obligation will terminate.
3. That this agreement is fair and equitable, that both parties have both received consideration, specifically that Respondent will not attempt to eliminate his spousal support obligation, and that the parties have had full disclosure of their respective financial circumstances through the discovery process. Further that pursuant to Karon v. Karon, 435 N.W.2d 501 (Minn. 1989), and Minn. Stat. § 518.552, subd. 5, the Court is hereby divested of jurisdiction over the issue of spousal maintenance for either party in the future.
